LEGISLATIVE ALERT

The State of Wisconsin Assembly will vote Tuesday, December 11, 2008 on AB464, which is a measure to keep teenagers from talking on their cell phones while driving.

The sponsor of this bill further stated that he expects the proposal to get a hearing in the State Senate.

The bill must pass both the Assembly and the Senate in order to be signed by Governor Doyle before it can become law. If this passes Wisconsin will be the 16th state to limit or ban cell phone use by teenage drivers.

Please take the time to contact your Representative in the Assembly and your Wisconsin State Senator today and tell them that as a member and with the full support of the Wisconsin PTA you support this bill that could save lives of children, youth and families across Wisconsin.
